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Please refer to the letter of Thiru K. Rajamani, Velachery Dhandeeswar Nagar published in your newspaper stating that stagnant water in front of Raja Kalyana Mandapam.

In this regard , it is informed that Velachery Main Road near the Raja Kalyanamandapam is a low lying pocket and during rainy days this location gets water logged immediately. As there is no storm water drain in Velachery Main Road, people in the area allow the stagnated rain water to enter into the manholes by damaging the edges of the frames of the manholes. Due to this reason solid matters enter into the manholes causing sewer obstruction and sewage over flow. Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board has immediately attended to the sewage obstructions whenever they occur. The damaged manhole doors are replaced then and there. There is no sewer obstruction at present .

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
